I. An introduction to working with larger systems.

Participants will explore how professional Marriage and Family Therapists can work with larger systems to develop collaborative, multidisciplinary systems of intervention. They will explore the nature of different types of systems, the services most suited to each type, and practical ways to market to larger systems.

II. The core skills and deliverables

Participants will get an introduction into the basic processes and structures of providing professional services to larger systems. This will include the use of exploratory meetings, developing a proposal, contracting, the development of a fee schedule, and deliverables.

III. Ethics of working with larger systems

Participants will get a basic introduction to the ethics of working with larger systems. Included will be an identification of the similarities and differences of ethical clinical practice to providing contracted services, including behavioral health services, coaching, and consulting.

Course Objectives

After completing the workshop, participants will...

- understand the benefits and challenges of working with larger systems.
- develop awareness of the need to engage larger systems to impact greater numbers of people
- identify opportunities for working collaboratively with larger systems to improve outcomes for the larger system's employees, volunteers, or members
- understand the types of services provided for larger systems.
- understand the basic structure and process of developing a contract to work with larger systems.
- increase their awareness of the tools for consulting with larger systems including, exploratory meetings, proposals, contracting, developing a fee structure, creating a fee schedule and deliverables — such as executive summaries.
- increase awareness of the specific ethical challenges of working with larger systems and means of providing ethical practice to reduce the risks.
