- If you are an AAMFT Approved Supervisor in good standing, you must complete a one-hour, board approved CE training on KY Law
- If you are not an AAMFT-approved supervisor, but have been licensed at least five years, and you have completed a board approved supervision course (six-hour course), you must complete 2 hours of CE training in supervision and KY Law.

Training is provided at a cost of \$25 per hour

- One-hour Law classes are \$25/hour if taken by themselves
- Supervision is \$25

About the Presenters

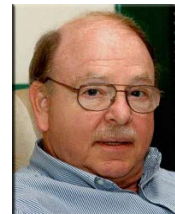


Dale E. Bertram, PhD
